

# Achievement in Construction, Refurbishment and Fitout

*For applying exceptional construction processes to a project that has reached practical completion or a significant milestone*

## **Purpose and Recognition**

This award recognises women who have made a significant contribution to construction, refurbishment or fit out of a building located in New South Wales.

This award recognises achievement in applying exceptional construction processes to a project that has reached practical completion or a significant milestone, irrespective of project scale.

## **Eligibility**

Any woman who has been involved in the construction of a project in New South Wales in a management or supervisory role is eligible for this award, including but not limited to, construction managers, project managers, site engineers, contract administrators, supervisors, forepersons or leading hands who successfully managed complex components of a project which was delivered on time and within budget.

Nominations for this award may be made by a nominee or a third party, provided that the nominee(s) has provided their consent to the nomination.

## **How to Nominate**

1. Register online and enter all required details on the online entry page.
2. Read and agree to be bound by the NAWIC NSW Terms and Conditions.
3. Complete the online submission to meet the requirements of the assessment criteria.
4. Ensure the online entry includes the following:
  - a. nominee details;
  - b. nominee biography;
  - c. assessment criteria;
  - d. a description of the relevant project;
  - e. a letter of endorsement;

- f. a letter of property/project owner consent;
- g. a good quality, professional image of the nominee; and
- h. five (5) images of the relevant project.

## **Assessment Criteria**

Nominees will be assessed by a panel of industry volunteers based on how they have demonstrated significant contribution to a project.

Nominees must address the following assessment criteria:

1. Provide details of the nominee's role and any unique features, restrictions, complexities and other relevant information about the project.
2. Provide details of the nominee's contribution, including any exceptional construction processes implemented.
3. Provide evidence that the project reached practical completion or a significant milestone between 1 March 2020 and 30 June 2021.
4. Describe the quality of the construction outcome achieved.
5. Provide details of innovation and/or processes applied to the project by the nominee.
6. Outline any efficiencies achieved in the project including monitoring and management of programme and costs
