- 3. NAWIC's goal is 25% female participation in the Australian Construction Industry by 2025. Outline three key policies or practices your business has implemented or is implementing that will play a part in reaching this goal.



- 4. Outline your long-term goals and strategies around female participation and gender equity within your business.
- 5. Describe in one sentence what you would do if you could fix the gender imbalance and increase the ratio of women in the construction industry.
- 6. What is the female employment rate within your business
